

Woodforde's Brewery

Tour Health and Safety Requirements

Before the tour, the tour guide will deliver a safety briefing covering the potential hazards within the brewery.

As a visitor to Woodforde's Brewery, you are expected to follow the safety requirements. The key points from these are detailed below. Please familiarise yourself with these points.

Please note: Breweries are Food Factories, and the maintenance of hygiene standards is a continuous process.

- Visitors must **remain with the guide at all times** and follow any instruction given verbally or signage within the brewery.
- The brewery is a food production premises and visitors **must not eat (including the chewing of gum), drink, or smoke** while inside the production premises and on the tour.
 - This is a **Nut Free site** and no food with peanuts or traces of nuts are to be consumed on the premises.
- To reduce the risk of contamination, **any belongings containing food, drinks or medicines must remain in the brewery shop** before entering the brewery.
- Excessive use of aftershave/perfume, wearing nail polish, false nails and false eyelashes are not permitted within production areas.
- Help us to maintain cleanliness in our production areas and housekeeping standards by **using waste bins around the site, disposing of waste appropriately and washing hands after using washrooms or eating/drinking/smoking.**
- Please inform the tour guide if you are **suffering from or have been in contact with any infectious diseases.**
 - You **must declare** this to your tour guide, and we reserve the right to refuse entry into the production area.
- In the event of an emergency, **follow the instructions of the tour guide who will assist you to exit the building.**
 - The **fire assembly point is in the customer car park.**
- **Be always aware of vehicle movements around you**, even if the brewery doesn't appear to be operation.
- This is a working brewery and as such, there will be equipment or otherwise that **if disrupted, may cause injury. Be cautious about touching, moving, leaning on things around you.**
- **Appropriate shoes and clothing should be worn to avoid slips, trips or falls.** Shoes should be **fully enclosed, non-slip shoes** that cover both toes and heels.
 - **If you do not have appropriate clothing or footwear, you will not be allowed to enter the brewery.**
- There is a large number of steps and confined spaces. **Visitors who have mobility issues or special requirements may not be able to complete the full tour.**
- You will be provided a high visibility jacket before entering the brewery. **This must be kept on at all times** when on the premises until you return to the shop.
- **Follow the site safety rules and instructions given.**

We reserve the right to refuse entry to anyone who, in the opinion of the Woodforde's staff, is not fit to go on the tour. Any inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated to ensure the safety of our staff and customers.
